



Scott Brown Stands with Romney and Republicans to Repeal Health Care Reform

Elizabeth Warren Supports Ruling to Protect Massachusetts Families

While Senator Scott Brown agrees with Mitt Romney and other Republicans that the Affordable Care Act should be repealed, U.S. Senate candidate Elizabeth Warren believes that we should be focused on protecting and helping Massachusetts families, not refighting the battles of two years ago.

“Massachusetts led the way on health reform, and we will continue to lead the way in our efforts to reduce the costs of health care,” Warren said. “Our country now needs to move forward to create jobs and opportunity for all Americans—not fight endless political battles.”

The Affordable Care Act is improving the health care of Massachusetts residents in a variety of ways:

- **70,000 Massachusetts residents** with Medicare have saved an average of **\$648** on their prescription drugs
- **780,000 people** with Medicare have received free preventive services, such as colonoscopies and mammograms
- **1.3 million people** in Massachusetts have had preventive services added to their private insurance plan without cost sharing
- **2.5 million Massachusetts residents** no longer have a lifetime limit on their health insurance plan
- **More than 20,000 young adults** in Massachusetts have received health insurance by being added to their parents’ insurance plans
- **\$107 million** is being invested in community health centers
- **85,000 Massachusetts families** will receive an average of **\$140** in rebates, based on a rule requiring insurance companies to spend most of the money from premiums on health care

“This decision ensures that millions of children, seniors, and families will continue to benefit from health care reform,” said Warren. “By upholding this legislation, the Supreme Court has ensured that every American can get access to high quality, affordable health care and fair treatment from insurance companies.”

The Affordable Care Act also creates health care exchanges and provides tax credits for small businesses to make it easier for small business owners and entrepreneurs to get affordable health care coverage for themselves and their employees.
